

Special types General Order 2003 – an explanation

Introduction

Most equipment used on roads is covered by the Construction and Use (C & U) regulations. The Special Types General Order (STGO) regulations relate to vehicles and loads that are not covered by the C & U regulations. This summary covers the STGO regulations which cover the use of vehicles carrying abnormal loads.

An abnormal load is defined as:

- (i) A load that cannot without due expense or risk or damage be divided into two or more loads (indivisible load), and which cannot be carried on a normal vehicle covered by the C & U regulations due to its dimensions or
- (ii) The combined weight of the vehicle and its load exceeds 44,000 kgs.

STGO vehicle and load combined weights are divided into 3 categories

Gross combined weight up to	Category
50,000 kgs	Category 1
80,000 kgs	Category 2
150,000 kgs	Category 3
